



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

## THE GOLDEN JUBILEE CELEBRATION - 2023

Coming together having causal interaction or gossiping at occasional places among a group of socially enlightened youth stationed at Leh hailing from different villages of Ladakh doing government jobs and different professional livelihood during late 1960's being among the first new generation emerged out of the newly introduced modern education in Ladakh resulted into serious discussion and debates over the prevailing social, cultural and educational issues of Ladakhi society. Their daily interaction steadily enthused strong bases of determination and resoluteness in them to do something for the welfare or service of the new emerging Ladakhi society around them. They found serious issues, problems, lacunas, challenges and negligence hindering the proper growth of Ladakhi society socially, educationally and economically. Besides, their strong appreciation of the cultural environment, their urges to preserve and further their heritages, traditions, art and literature driven them as a social force to reckon with the changing new circumstances in Ladakh.

## Broadly they felt:-

- 1. That there is an urgent need of thrust in improving the standard of education in Ladakh and accessibility of education to all the children particularly the poor and of the remote villages in general.
- That the rich and valued cultural heritages of Ladakh are at the verge of utmost neglect and decay, which needed to be preserved and promoted.
- 3. That the social evils prevalent in Ladakhi society particularly among the Buddhist community as polyandry, inequality in society, emerging new dowry system and few customary practices are detrimental to the healthy growth of the society which needed to be eradicated.
- 4. That there need a thrust in propagating basics of Buddhism to make

- society more harmonious, more compassionate and morally robust encouraging helping hands towards each other.
- 5. Therefore, these youth with the consultation of legal experts organized themselves into a welfare and charitable society in the name and style of "LAMDON SOCIAL WELFARE SOCIETY" head quartered at Leh. The constitution and the bye-laws were drafted by Tsering Samphel, who was then a practising petition writer in Leh courts in the year 1970 and got it registered under the J&K Societies Registration Act in the year 1973 vide registration No. 183/S dated 12th July, 1973. The first Working Committee was formed with Ven. Lama Thupstan Paldan (President), Shri. Morup Tharchin Namochok and Nimoo Shingkhan Nurbu (Vice-Presidents) Sh. Tsering Samphel, Heshuk (General Secretary), Shri TharookNorbu (Treasurer) and Shri. Morup Namgyal Wanla (Director Cultural Wing) with many others as members.

The Society started its activities through Lectures, Dramas, Skits, Songs and Dances exposing the social evils in Ladakhi Buddhist Society, under the direction of Morup Namgyal whose popularity as a famous singer of Ladakhi folk songs during a drama show staged in 1965 to raise funds for the relief of UP and Bihar draught effected people, was at climax. Lamdon Society organized many events in a many major populated villages for years together. More than 50 songs were composed by Morup Namayal and Lama Thupstan Paldan and their popularity made an impressive impact in eradication of some of the burning social evils in Buddhist society. The popularity of the cultural events organized by Shri. Morup Namayal and Lamdon members picked up to such a climax that some of the social evils were hated on as sins in society. The polyandry system and dowry system were particularly targeted upon and these theatre shows and their impact in society were an epoch making chapter in the success stories of the Lamdon Social Welfare Society. The missionary zeal and the dedication of the members of the newly constituted Lamdon Society in fulfilling its vision and objectives remained exemplary and unstained all along. From its modest beginning, the society has made rapid progress in achieving many of the exemplary goals particularly

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in educational field in Ladakh. The Drama Shows accrued handsome capital amount as income strengthening its capacity to surge ahead in the struggle to achieve its targeted goals and missions.

## LAMDON MODEL SCHOOL- A PIONEERING MISSION IN LADAKH

The soil of Ladakh is a blessed one, when India got independence, Ladakh became a part of it and coincidently Ladakh got a great visionary leader to represent it in the new democratic set up of the Union of India. The 19th Kushok Bakula Rinpoche was the best choice of the then great Prime Minister of India Pt. Jawahar Lal Nehru who assigned him as the leader of Ladakh during his maiden visit to Ladakh on 4th July, 1949. Kushok Bakula Rinpochhe was declared nominated then as the President of Jammu & Kashmir National Conference Party of Ladakh Chapter, An official hand-out of SheikhMohd Abudullah, the then Wazire-e-Azam of J&K State as President of the J&K National Conference, (who was accompanying Panditji during the visit) was issued in Leh in this regard. Kushok Bakula Rinpoche was then just 31 years old and was in Ladakh for a short sojourn after his completion of Geshe Lharampa Degree "Doctorate in Buddhist Philosophy" in Tibet. Once Kushok Bakula Rinpoche assumed the leadership of Ladakh, his first visionary mission started with a strong zeal to spread awareness among the innocent, backward and illiterate people of Ladakh of the importance of education as the only panacea for their future prosperity and development. His immediate initiative was followed by opening new Government Schools in all major populated villages and all the children stepped into these schools enmass.

Despite the concerted focus on education, the unavailability of qualified teachers, dearth of trained hands, and above all irrelevant curriculum remained a stumbling block in the proper development of education in Ladakh for decades together. Urdu used to be medium of instruction with least space to learn local language with further complication when students had to shift over to English from standard sixth. Therefore, function of Government Schools and proper education in Ladakh remained at lowest ebb for decades. The poor literacy rate of 10% in 1961 of Ladakh

had hardly touched 15% by 1971. Pass percentage of students in class 10<sup>th</sup> standard remained 0-2% during 1947-1973. So, there was a consensus among the Lamdon members that what ever possible an intervention in improving education standard needed to be first priority. The members of the society clearly foresaw education as the main tool for dispelling ignorance as well as the preservation and enrichment of the cultural wealth of Ladakh. The Bank balance of Rs.29,000/- out of successful Drama Shows directed by Morup Namgyal and Lamdon members as artists of the Drama shows further encouraged the Lamdon members to venture something solid in improvements of education quality in Ladakh. Tsering Samphel mooted a proposal to start a private school in Leh as a pioneering adventure to boost a model in Ladakh towards improvements in education quality. The proposal, its feasibility and variability was discussed among a limited circle of Lamdon members as Gelong Paldan, Morup Namgyal, Murup Tharchin, Sonam Norbu and Tharook Norbu etc. Afterwards the proposal was taken up with its mentor Geshes Ishey TundupStokpa, who appreciated the idea very high and boosted the morale of the team. It was in the month of March, 1971 that the proposal to start a school by Lamdon Society was approved with consensus and unanimously in a General Body Meeting of Lamdon Social Welfare Society. The decision could not be implemented for two years due to multifarious reasons. Ultimately, it was in September 1973, that Lamdon Model School was started with 07 Students on roll under Morup Namayal as Headmaster in a 04 room tenements belonging to Hemis Gonpa in Leh where presently the Rabsal Parking is located. Kushok Bakula Rinpoche was the Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha) from Ladakh during those days. Lamdon members called Rinpocheji and sought his blessings and cooperation in the new initiative of Lamdon. Kushok Bakula Rinpoche has always been a moral booster to Lamdon School. On the other hand popularity of the newly started Lamdon School picked up with an unexpected speed because mainly of the fact that the native Bhoti language was being taught as the main subject of learning. Lamdon stressed the importance of learning its own Ladakhi language and culture, alongside the usual national curriculum subjects including Mathematics, Science, English and Social Science. Lamdon Society decided to base its school at Takskithang area where the Deputy Commissioner Leh demarcated a huge chunk of area for allotment

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to Lamdon School for which Sankar Gonpa raised no objection, though the wild Shrubs grown over there at Takskithang barren land used to be the source of fuel for cooking purpose in Sankar Gonpa for ages, and they had exclusive right over there. The fact that its supreme patriarch Kushok Bakula Rinpoche had deep appreciation over the Lamdon activities, who conjoined special happiness over the shifting of Lamdon School at Takskithang. The first 06 roomed School building was built at Takskitang with the physical voluntary Shramdaan of the members of Lamdon Society on Sundays and holidays for months together. It was a historical event that after the conclusion of the first ever Kalachakra initiation in Ladakh by His Holiness the 14th Dalai Lama in September, 1976 organized by Ladakh Buddhist Association, the first new building of Lamdon Model School was inaugurated by H.H the 14th Dalai Lama, Gyalwang Tenzin Gyatso on 12th of September, 1976 at Takskithang, Leh. Most Venerable Kushok Bakula Rinpoche, Thiksey Rinpoche, Togdan Rinpoche, Stakna Rinpoche, Geshe Ishey Tundup, Gergan Kunchok Sonam, Hemis Chagzot, Gedun of Samkar Gonpa, galaxy of VIPs, elderly and senior citizens of Leh, members of Lamdon Social Welfare Society and other around 2000 residents of the surrounding habitants participated in the grand function. The school was shifted over there and functioning at the new site of Takskitahna since then.

The blessings of His Holiness the Dalai Lama has seen the biggest booster right from the beginning that Lamdon School developed and bounds towards its noble destination. In the year 1976, His Holiness had deputed Shri Dhondup Dorje, a highly educated Tibetan young man to Lamdon School, who as Principal of the School for two decades, spotted Lamdon School as one of the most reputed and sought after school in Ladakh for admission of their children. Shri Dhondup Dorji successfully laid a solid foundation of an exceptional educational institution of its brand 'Lamdon' which proved immense inspiration in energizing and empowering the schooling system in Ladakh in a resource- efficient manner. Shri Dhondup Dorje was succeeded by Shri Eshey Tondup (Temog) in the year 1996, who volunteered to serve Lamdon School as Principal sacrificing his lucrative Government job. Had he continued in Government Education Department, he could have retired as Director Education. It was Eshey Tondup, who with his dedication, efficiency

and hard work, led Lamdon School to shine as one of the shining stars in the galaxy of educational institution in Ladakh. Today, Dr. Stanzin Dawa, a dynamic young, talented and highly experienced Principal, head the institution efficiently and smoothly, who succeeded Shri Eshey Tondup as Principal on his superannuation in the year 2018.

Right from the beginning, students from hapless poor family backgrounds, the abandoned ones by their parents and the orphanages who needed support were identified and given preference in admission into Lamdon School. By 1980, there were around 350 such students who were getting freeship in Lamdon School and these days too there are 315 sponsored students on roll. Their tuition fee, books and stationeries were being sponsored by the sympathizers of Lamdon Society. First of all some European friends were introduced to Lamdon School by the then member of Parliament from Ladakh Rani Deskit Wangmo of Stok in 1978, when they had come to Ladakh as tourists. Mention of many prominent philanthropist among many as the first being Mrs. Irmtraut Wager of Germany who throughout her life rendered her in measurable financial and moral support to Lamdon School are listed at Annexure 'A' which include many benevolent organization also.

Over the years, Lamdon School being co-ed under CBSE affiliation has grown to a Higher Secondary level with 1988 students on roll as on today with 80 teaching staff and 50 non- teaching staff. Not a semblance of complaint ever heard against any teaching staff of the school throughout the last 50 long years signifies their commendable talents, dedication and devotion. The efficiency of the non- teaching staff have too been a big contribution in the progression of the school. Infrastructure of the school and the society are at Annexure "A" which are par excellence in whole of Ladakh. The present annual budget involvement in the school and hostel are to the tune of Rs. 6.16 crore. Around 9000 children have taken admission in Leh Lamdon School excluding the ones in other 7 feeder schools all over Ladakh so far. A well-established boarding hostel of the student at Leh is hosting 225 boys and 225 girls students mostly sponsored as freeship ones. One deserving student each years of the school of class X examination are given admission at united Mahindra college Pune to pursue their class 11th & 12th on 100% scholarship. The scholarship

have been possible only because of the collective action and generousity of the staff at UWCSEA. They have created this opportunity for desrving Lamdon students many years through partnership with Lamdon. Lamdon School has a security cash reserve of Rs. 12.19 core in shape of FDRs. Lamdon Model Senior Secondary School Leh has been ranked the 13th in the Top-20 best Day-cum-Boarding school in India, No. 1 in J&K and No.1 in Leh in the year 2018 in a national level survey conducted by 'Education Today' e-magazine. Lamdon School is proud of having IAS, IPS, KAS, KPS and a galaxy of Doctors, Engineers, Scientist, Researcher and other shining alumni to its tall credential and now stands as the most reputed educational institution in Ladakh. For incessant and untiring work in the welfare of children and for providing quality education, the Government of India Ministry of Human Resources Development, New Delhi conferred the prestigious Child Welfare National Award to Lamdon Social Welfare Society, Leh in the Year 1992 with a citation and cash of Rs. 2 Lakh. Similarly, Mahabodhi International Meditation Centre has awarded "Acharya Buddha Rakhita Humanitarian Award"-2002 and Ladakh Buddhist Association Leh has conferred the "Bharat Ratna, Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Award" in 2009 for its outstanding services to the Ladakhi Society.

Lamdon School is a community school committed to educational excellence, where students are given opportunity to identify their potential to become champions in life and make constructive contribution to the society. The institution of Lamdon's dimension was not built in a day. The wheel of Lamdon started rolling in 1973 and continued its services in providing quality education to the society as envisioned by the founders. Lamdon was not incepted with a business motive and monetary profit but largely for charitable purpose and to serve the society with dedicative love, compassion and Karuna.

## SOME OTHER ACTIVITIES OF LAMDON SOCIAL WELARE SOCIETY

Members of Lamdon Society have been rendering volunteer services whenever a natural calamity struck such as cloud burst, flood, flash flood etc. in Ladakh and their humanitarian services in clearance of debris, restoration of irrigational Kuhls as well as drinking water to affected areas and rehabilitation

activities have been exemplary. Lamdon society rendered huge cash relief to the effected people in such calamities besides members of society also extended their individual cash contribution in all such calamities in the past. Over the years Lamdon Social Welfare Society remained always the most benevolent in extending cash contribution to the poor patients of Ladakh who very oftenly needed financial support for their surgery and treatment outside Ladakh. Members of the society remain always first in blood donations whenever and wherever needed. Lamdon society holds medical camps at least thrice a year in remote areas of Ladakh, where health services are rendered to few thousand patients every year at their door steps. These medical camps include Amchi system of medical facilities also.

A 4 wheel drive, 2 bedded vehicle serving Ladakh since 1993 as a mobile health facility. By the year 1995, this mobile clinic had done 55 visits to remote villages in Ladakh. A clinic in the city center of Leh equipped with ultra sound diagnostic machine had served the people of Ladakh from the year 1995 for years together as the high fat content of the traditional Ladakhi diet had led to a high prevalence of kidney and gall stone conditions and the ultra-sound machine had been invaluable in diagnosing these conditions at an early stage. From the year 1996, Lamdon had a blood diagnostic machine too and a portable X-Ray machine serving the patients in thousands for years together all over Ladakh.

The Society's motto "Welfare of the Society" is carried out with utmost talents of the members of the Lamdon Society and the society has the credibility of being the pioneering voluntary and charitable society in philanthropic activities and above all it has the name and fame being the first NGO in Ladakh enabling more than 500 similar other NGOs to come up in its replication over the years since 1970s in Ladakh. It was Lamdon Society who has shown the ways and means to run private schools and NGO in Ladakh. Today there are about 113 private schools in Ladakh, supplementing Government endeavour in improving quality education in Ladakh. The greater contribution of Lamdon society in Ladakh are that it pioneered theatre shows, it pioneered running of educational institution, it pioneered functioning of NGOs, it pioneered identification of social evils

and their eradication, it pioneered social debates and dialogue, above all it awakened the society that they are themselves responsible for shaping their fate and future.

Lamdon Society launched cleanliness campaign way back in late 1960's and its replication is in place today in Leh. It was Lamdon Society, who awakened society's responsibility to contribute their share in establishing harmonious society, brotherhood and sense of interdependency so that a peaceful society is shaped thereby contributing towards world peace and prosperity. That was why, Lamdon Society organize a 15 day mass gathering at Leh Chokhang Vihara every year in the 1st sacred month of Buddhist lunar calendar. The whole session is presided over by a Buddhist scholar or a venerable Rinpoche who teaches world peace through mind purification on the lines of Buddha's teachings. Recitation of 10 crore of "MANI" comprises –OM MANE PADME HUN is conducted each year since 1975. A lot of charity activities as Dhana to the poor, food services in Bal Ashram, Old age home at MIMC and indoor patients in SNM hospital are performed throughout these 15 days every year.

We all have been affected by Covid-19 pandemic. It had devastated effects on human life. Some people did not get necessary equipment to keep themselves safe from corona virus, in such situation Lamdon Society had come forward to help the needy people of Ladakh. The Society had organized Covid awareness & support camps at far-off regions of Ladakh like Zanskar, Nubra and Changthang. In these camps the equipment like Mask, Sanitizers, Hand Gloves, and Sunglasses etc. were distributed among the local people.

#### MAJOR SUCCESS STORIES OF LAMDON SOCIAL WELFARE SOCIETY

It was LSWS, Leh who Started the pioneering first regulated private school in Ladakh in the year 1973, which has been replicated all over Ladakh and today there are 113 private schools in Ladakh (67 in kargil District and 46 in Leh District) with 29,292 students on rolls. These private schools have 3,502 students more on rolls than the total students in 904 Government educational

institutions in Ladakh as per Government data's of 2021 available. Lamdon School is rendering a yeo-man services to the Ladakhi society in the field of education for the last 50 years under the spiritual guidance and blessings of His Holiness the 14<sup>th</sup> Dalai Lama, with the unflinching moral and financial support from our well-wishers at national and international level and the strong dedication, sincerity and commitments of the staff members.

A high valued building asset owned by Lamdon Social Welfare Society at Sarnath (Varanasi) in Utter Pradesh is serving as a Dharamsala for the accommodation of visiting pilgrims particularly from Ladakh since 1980's. This building was initially on rent by Most Ven. Kushok Bakula Rinpoche for about a 20 students from Ladakh during 1960's to 1980's as hostel, who were taken there for education in Mahabodhi School, Sarnath by Most Ven Kushok Bakula Rinpoche. A serious letigation about this building between Kushok Bakula Rinpoche and the owner for year's culminated into a compromise and Most Ven Kushok Bakula Rinpoche inspired Lamdon to buy the building and it was Kushok Baula Rinpoche who made Lamdon an owner of a globally valued asset in Sarnath. This building in this way became a symbol of yet another service activity by Lamdon to the Buddhist of Ladakh. It is pertenant to mention that the then Government of Jammu and Kashmir State had also helped Lamdon to meet some portion of the heavy price Lamdon had to pay in purchasing the building from the owner.

The major and main attraction of the Lamdon School has been its secular characteristic, where only modern scientific approach matters in shaping the new generation of Ladakh proud of its own cultural heritage, its perservance and enrichment, communal harmony, values of inter-dependency support by love, compassion and Karuna.

 LSWS is the pioneering NGO in Ladakh who created awareness in Ladakh Society of its rich cultural heritage of ancient folk songs, folklores and music, which were at the verge of extinction under the preceding 114 years of Dogra rules. Lamdon Social welfare society ventured in reviving them introducing Drama/Theatre/stages,

thereby popularizing them through talented singers like Morup Namgyal, talented musicians in local instruments like Kidar Angchok and talented music composer like Phunchok Tsering Spituk inspired and guided by legendry scholar Shri. Tashi Rabgias, Tukchupa. Now, there are galaxy of famous singers and musician in Ladakh inspired by the initiatives of Lamdon Social Welfare Society.

The annual recitation of "Mane Tungchhur" has been the magna carta of ancient Ladakh culture, which according to Buddhist belief promotes love, compassion and Karuna leading to mind peace, prosperity in Society and sense of security and safety from all evil calamities. Recitation of "Mane Tungchhur" which used to be held in ancient times under the patronages of royal families had ceased for the last 114 years under the dominances of Dogra regime. Lamdon Social Welfare society restarted the "Mane Tungchhur" recitation in the year 1975 in Chowkhang Vehara Leh on the insistence of previous Thuksay Nawang Gurmet Palzangpo (1916-1983). "Mane Tungchhhur" means recitation of ten crores of "Om Mani Padme Hun" the six syllable mantra of Avalokiteswara – the Bodhisattva who embodies the compassion of all Buddhas. This mantra is the essence of the purest Dhamma to promote your attitude free of the worldly concern leading to higher realm and liberation. The first "Mane Tungchhur" recitation when it was started on the first date of the first month of Tibetan calendar, the most sacred month of the year, (1975 of Christian era) it had to continue without break day & night till the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month with an approximated 700 to 2000 participants in attendance continuously, which was concluded on the day which was again the most sacred day for the Buddhists. The most unexpected good omen of the completion of the ten crores recitation of "Om Mane Padme Hun" coincided was then with a strong thundershower when Leh was facing unprecedented drought since 1969. It was from that year that Leh town never faced shortages of irrigational water till today. Now it is 48th years that Lamdon Social Welfare Society has been organizing this event without any break. The most success story with this noble initiative is that everywhere in Ladakh "Mani Tungchhur" "Vajra Guru Tungchhur" "Tara mantra" etc. have by now become a common yearly event, which credit squarely owe by Lamdon Social Welfare Society as these are the replications from Lamdon Society and Lamdon has a respectable space in Buddhist Society of Ladakh all over.

3. It was Lamdon Social Welfare Society, who arranged teaching to the masses in an accessible centrally located venue with all arrangement of comfortable seating heating and relevant text availability. It was in the winter month of 1970, a month long with 3 hours each day teaching by Geshe Ishey Tundup of Stok on "LAMRIM" text authored by Je Tsongkapa Lobzang Drakpa (1357-1419) which created a trend in Buddhist Society, enthusing interest among the young Buddhist employees serving in different departments at Leh being the headquarter of the District of Ladakh. Around 300 devotees attended the teaching including some officers. The 400-paged "LAMRIM" text was made available by cyclostyling copies from the master text on daily basis by Lamdon Society. Today this type of teaching is being arranged by various NGO's all over Ladakh on the inspiration drawn from Lamdon Society.
